Our goal is to support individuals who participate in therapeutic riding programs the chance to ride in a horse show and experience the atmosphere, the thrill, and the joy of the show ring with an energetic crowd to cheer them on. Each participant will receive a ribbon. There will be lots of fun activities before and after each class for all riders and non-riders to enjoy.

Show Rules

1. All participants must sign a waiver to participate. Appropriate clothing must be worn at all times, including hard toed shoes and ASTM-SEI standard helmets.
2. Each rider will be assigned their own number.
3. Current negative Coggins is required to show. Will be checked with entry.
4. Rider Divisions – Division A: 5 to 9; Division B: 10 to 14; Division C: 15 to Adult. Age as of January 1st.
5. Judge's decision is final.
6. Only service dogs are allowed on the show premises.
7. Horses must stay in horse area of the Fairgrounds.
8. No alcoholic beverages, profanity or unsportsmanlike conduct will be tolerated, person(s) may be asked to leave by show management.
9. Show management will not be held responsible for accidents or injuries to persons, animals or property on grounds.
10. Cost per class is \$6.00.
11. Horses provided by entrant or entrant's organization.
11. All participants will receive a ribbon.
12. Classes may be combined based on the number of participants.
