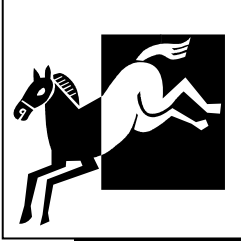

SEI-ASTM helmets and hard toed shoes are required, along with a current Coggins form.

Directions to the Howard County Fairgrounds: **From Baltimore:** Take 70 West to Route 32 South exit (Exit 80). Make a left onto Route 32. Make a right onto Frederick Road (Route 144) West. Make a right onto Fairgrounds Road.

From Frederick: Take 70 East to Route 32 North exit (Exit 80). Make a right onto Route 32. Make a right onto Frederick Road (Route 144) West. Make a right onto Fairgrounds Road.

Note: Do not travel down the midway to the show rings. Please follow the signs to the Horse Show entrance.
